## Code of Conduct for Players

Conquerors Junior Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of netball has introduced a Players' Code of Conduct. We ask all those involved in netball follow these guidelines to ensure that all games and tournaments are played in the best spirit of the game.

- 1. Be conversant and observe the rules of the game.
- 2. Play fairly, be competitive but not aggressive.
- 3. During play do not question a decision by the umpires either by gesture, look, verbally or by commenting to another player.
- 4. Give the ball promptly to opponents' throw-ins, penalty shots, free and penalty passes etc.
- 5. Ensure you are in the correct position indicated by the umpire when penalties are set.
- 6. Keep your self-control at all times and do not retaliate. Do not use obscene language at any time.
- 7. Accept victory modestly and defeat graciously, you are representing your club who will be judged on your behaviour.
- 8. Shake hands with your opponent at the end of the game, regardless of the outcome.
- 9. Thank your Captain, Coach and Parent after your match.
- 10. Enjoy your Netball

## Code of Conduct for Parents, Cares and Supporters

Conquerors Junior Netball Club, in its continuing effort to increase the enjoyment and participation of the game of netball has introduced a Code of Conduct. We ask all those involved in netball follow these guidelines to ensure that all games and tournaments a played in the best spirit of the game

- 1. Do not force unwilling children to participate in netball.
- 2. Remember children are involved in netball for their enjoyment not yours.
- 3. Encourage your child to play to the rules and not to argue with umpires or other officials.
- 4. Teach your child that honest effort is more important than victory so the result of the game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- 5. Turn losing into winning by helping your child work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship.
- 6. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 7. Remember children learn best by example, applaud good play by your team or the opposition.
- 8. Do not question the umpire's decision or honesty, remember that they are only human with the same feelings as you and can sometimes make an honest mistake.
- 9. Recognise the importance and value of coaches who are all volunteers, they give children their time and resources to provide netball for your child.
- 10. Read the rules of netball to understand better what you are watching and commenting on.
- 11. Promote this Code of Conduct to other parents, cares and supporters.
- 12. Coaches decision on team selection and playing position should be supported at all times.
- 13. Parents behaviour deemed abusive or unnecessary at training or match could lead to your daughter being asked to leave Conquerors.
